Eastern Institute of Technology, Napier New Zealand

DURATION:

The duration of study for the BBA Degree shall extend over a period of three academic years, one year in SJCC and the other two years in Swansea University, UK/ Eastern Institute of technology, New Zealand. In SJCC, each academic year comprises of two semesters.

ELIGIBILITY:

Students who have completed their two year Pre-University course of Karnataka State or equivalent thereto are eligible to seek admission to the BBA degree course.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

- The Three year BBA degree program is divided into six semesters. Students under this program will complete their 1st year in SJCC and the 2nd and 3rd year abroad.
- Students enrolled under the international twinning program will have to score an aggregate of 60 percent in each subject at SJCC in order to be eligible to continue the program.

- The final degree will be awarded by the Foreign University/ Institution.
- Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).

 counseling sessions and personal networking opportunities.
