This also has a bearing on the way we understand culture, education and democracy and the nature of their interrelatedness. A nation that was originally imagined on the foundations of the consensual notions of liberalism and secularism has now to contend with alternative and conflicting notions of nation, identity and entitlement.

Thus the seminar would attempt to trace how the present day tension between multiple discourses of power, culture and identity is redefining the provenance of higher education. The seminar further hopes to facilitate re-thinking these concepts of vital importance that will impinge on our lived experience, in times to come. The seminar also hopes to engender a constructive dialogue between differing world views and perspectives on the crucial notions of democracy, education and the nation.

The seminar is structured as a cluster of three sessions:

Session-I: Culture, Identity and Democracy

Session-II: Higher Education and Multiculturalism

Session-III: Reimagining the Nation

ABSTRACT

Abstracts related to the theme of the seminar are invited in the following format:

Word limit: 250-300

Font: Times New Roman, 12 points with 1.5 spacing

Keywords: 4 – 5

The cover page should bear only the title of the paper, names of the author, official address, email ids, phone numbers of the authors and a brief profile.
