MINUTES OF THE RESEARCH ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING

The Research Advisory Committee (RAC) meeting was held on 31st October, 2022 at 3.00 p.m., in the Board Room, SJCC.

Members of Advisory Committee Present: 07 (list enclosed)

The meeting started at 3:00 pm in the College Board room with a silent prayer followed by the Principal, Charles Lasrado SJ, welcoming the members of the Advisory Committee of SJCC Research Centre.

Dr. Poornima Vijaykumar, Assistant Research Director presented the activities of the Research Centre, a brief note on the Ph.D. Scholars progress, and SJCC Management Research Review Journal before the Advisory Committee Members.

After the presentation, the Chairperson of the Committee, Dr. Charles Lasrado SJ (Principal and Research Director of SJCC), chaired the meeting. In his opening remarks, he commended the performance of the SJCC Research Centre.

The summary of the deliberations:

 Dr. D. Raja Jebasingh, Research Supervisor, communicated to the floor that the BJES Minor Research Project nomenclature should be changed to BJES Institutional Seed Money Project. Dr. Raja Jebasingh also said that the nomenclature change should be in line with the NAAC and NIRF ranking agencies requirements.

* Dr. Nirmala Joseph, Registrar, suggested that the Research Centre should get an official letter centre from the Bengaluru City University (BCU) regarding the renewal recognition status of the research centre. The Principal communicated to the members that Dr. Raja Jebasingh, Vice Principal (Liaison) will follow up with the University about the same.

❖ The advisory committee appreciated the progress of the Ph.D. scholars who are registered under the SJCC Research Centre.

The committee resolved that the Ph.D. scholars need not report to the SJCC Research Centre after submission of their thesis to the Bangalore University. However, the scholars are expected to inform the Research Centre about the open defence dates.

The committee advised that necessary steps should be taken to get more research papers for the SJCC Management Research Review (MRR) Journal. Dr. Charles, suggested that the Research Centre could contact the PG HOD, Dr. Komal Dave to provide 2-3 best research articles converted from the dissertation projects for publication in the journal. Dr. Charles also suggested that up to two research articles may be invited from the SJCC faculty members for publication in the SJCC MRR Journal. The floor of the

house accepted the suggestion to include up to two articles of the SJCC faculty, per issue.

- ❖ Dr. Poornima Vijaykumar communicated to the floor that the Research Centre has applied for the UGC CARE List indexation of the SJCC Management Research Review journal in the month of March, 2022. The Principal opined that the Research Centre may share the application details along with unique number to Dr. Raja Jebasingh to follow up with the UGC office.
- ❖ Dr. Poornima Vijaykumar presented about the SJCC MRR journal website update to the committee members. Discussed the change in author's guidelines, journal archives and call-for-paper as the significant additions.
- ❖ The committee unanimously opined that the Seven Days National Level Experiential Workshop on "Research Methodology" may be conducted online mode if sufficient registrations are not received for offline mode. Decision to host the workshop online will be taken by mid-November.
- ❖ The committee suggested that the students should be encouraged for writing research articles and enhance the research culture through the respective departmental heads of the college.
- ❖ Dr. Charles Lasrado, drew the attention of the floor to the UGC Regulations regarding the starting of Ph.D. program in college by seeking permission from the Academic Council of the college. Dr. Nirmala Joseph opined that the UGC Regulations 2018 although specifies that autonomous colleges can start Ph.D. program but prior permission should be taken from the parent university. To seek more clarity, the former Principal of the college may be contacted for the same.
- ❖ Dr. Poornima Vijaykumar, Assistant Research Director appealed before the advisory committee that the Research Centre requires additional staffs for the managing the activities of the Centre. The Principal in response asked the Research Centre to suggest the relevant job profile and the qualifications of the staff required for assistance at the Research Centre.
- The chairperson and assistant research director responded to the comments and clarifications posed by the committee members.

The meeting was concluded after Principal extended thanks to the Research Advisory Committee Members present.
