Student ResearchEngagement

The Research Centre of the college, along with the subject teachers, guide and mentor the undergraduate and postgraduate students in research work. Research Methodology Paper is taught as part of the curriculum. Students are motivated to take upindependent research projects, and the research carried out by students in the form of case studies and research papers are compiled, edited and published by the college. Students are encouraged to engage research in the field of Commerce and Business Administration with an orientation of support the society in dealing with the diverse challenges. Research culture is an integral aspect of the curricular framework of the institution. The dissertations along with minor and major research projectsallow students to become industry-ready.

Activities and Achievements of the Research Centre in the

Academic Year 2021-2022

Research Centre renewed its Research Centre status under Bangalore City University for next five years.

Programmes Organized bythe Research Centre

I. Government Sponsored Events

a. AICTE Sponsored Faculty Development Programme:

In its endeavour to enhance research- oriented teaching pedagogy, a five-day national level Faculty Development Programme was organized by theResearch Centre from Oct 25 – 29, 2021. The programme was sponsored by ATAL Academy, a unit of AICTE. Dr. Deepika Joshi was the Course Director of theFaculty Development Programme. The key objective of the FDP was to help the researchers structure a case study and choose the right journal for publishing the case study. Learned professionals from IIMCalcutta, IIT Lucknow, NIT Hmirpur and VITVellore delivered the 14 sessions on topicsrelated to their area of expertise. 200 participants from nine different states of the country participated in the FDP.

b. ICSSR Sponsored ExperientialTraining Programme:

With an objective to expose scholarsto various elements of Research Methodology, a Seven -Day Training Programme was organized by the ResearchCentre from 18th April 2022 to 24th April 2022. The programme was sponsored by Indian Council of Social Science Research Southern Regional Centre, Hyderabad. Experienced professors from IIM Raipur,Pondicherry University, and PSG institute of Management conducted sessions on selected topics. The Workshop was organized under the leadership of Dr. Sridhar L. S., Workshop Director and Dr. D.Rajesh Jebasingh, Workshop Co-Director. The Workshop witnessed106 participants from eight states in India.

II. Management Sponsored CapacityBuilding Programmes

a. National Level Faculty developmentprogramme

In academic research, publishing articles injournals indexed by reputed agencies play a significant role in the career advancementof researchers and academicians. A National level FDP on "Research Writing and Publication" sponsored by SJCC was conducted on 10th and 11th of August 2021 by SJCC Research Centre. The firstday's session on the topic "Writing for Indexed Journal" was led by Dr. Ritika Mahajan, Assistant Professor MNIT Jaipur. The second day's session on the topic "Identification of Fake/Predatory/Cloned Journals in Academics" was delivered by Dr. Sumit Narula, Deputy Dean Research, Amity School of Communication and PublicRelations, Gwalior.

b. Faculty Development Programmefor In-house Faculty Members

The in-house faculty members attended a two-day FDP on 'Secondary Data Analysis'. Thirty faculty members participated in thisprogramme. Mr. Gurumurthy, Assistant Manager - Customer Support for Capital Market Publishers India Pvt. Ltd., shared the knowledge required to access capital market information from the CAPITALINE Database. Mr. Bipin, Senior Deputy Director of the EPW Research Foundation (EPWRF) in Mumbai demonstrated how to obtain time series data from the EPWRF database.Dr. P. Srinivasan, Associate Professor at theSchool of Management (SOM) at PresidencyUniversity in Bangalore, offered insights onusing E- Views to analyse time series data. Dr. Amuthan, Associate Professor at KarunyaUniversity in Coimbatore, presented forecasting modelling. The event was sponsored by the College Management.

III. PhD program of BangaloreUniversity

The three PhD scholars allocated under SJCC Research Centre from Bangalore University completed their PhD Viva. The details are mentioned below:

- Ms. Fozia Mehtab, PhD scholar guided by Dr. H. Nagaraj successfullydefended her PhD thesis on July 27, 2021. IV. Research Programme for the PG and UG Department

a. Experiential Training Programme on Research Methodology:

Research Centre of SJCC in collaboration with PG Department organized a six-day long experiential training programme for M.Com final year students from 1st September 2021 to 7th September 2021. The programme was organized with a view to enhance the research related skills of PG students and prepare them to undertake the dissertation work confidently. Seven sessions on various topics like research design, questionnaire construction, hypothesistesting, ethics in research, plagiarism policy of SJCC and UGC and writing the dissertationthesis and research articles were covered during the programme. Five faculty members from SJCC shared their knowledge and expertise with the students.

b. Workshop on Basic of Research Methodology for UG students

A Two-day workshop was organized on 17th and 21th September, 2021 for the BBA and B. Com students. Students of Quest Club and Mainframe Research forum participated in the workshop. They were trained on research, problem identification, hypothesis construction, questionnaire development, data collection and various data analysis techniques.

V. Guidance to the Departments

The Centre extends guidance to the Undergraduate and Postgraduate Departments in organizing the conference, workshops and seminars. The Centre provided support to thedepartments by reviewing the papers, compiling compendiums and also helping them with plagiarism check to follow publication ethics.

VI. Expert Review Committee Meeting – BJES Seed Money Projects

The Centre extended support by organizing Expert Review Committee meeting to scrutinize the proposals submitted by faculty members under BJES Seed Money Projects. Subject experts, Dr. Mohan Philip Associate Professor, Dr. Sheela, Associate Professor and Dr. Rajajeba Singh Assistant Professor at SJCC conducted the internal review on 25th and 26th February, 2022.
