Minutes of the meeting

The grievance Redressal Committee meeting was held on Wednesday 23rd February, 2022 in the board room at 11.00 am.

The meeting was convened by the Grievance Redressal Committee Coordinator Ms. Sneha Rai. It started with a prayer by Mr. Deenyar. The committee members expressed that the year was very challenging for the students due to various factors. The year saw the transformation of classes and examination from online to offline mode, the change in the curriculum structure due to the implementation of NEP 2020 for the first year students and uncertainty in the academic calendar. Dr. Raja Jebasingh expressed that on the whole the students felt that they were well supported for the transformation. Dr. Mohan Philip added that involvement of mentors and counsellors was well appreciated by faculty and students.

The members felt that in spite of the remedial classes students were not able to perform up to their ability in the odd semester exams due to partial online and partial offline classes. The mandatory Functional Kannada course for the NEP batch also created lot of anxiety for the students. During the year, the students' grievances were addressed and resolved to a satisfactory level. Ms. Sneha informed that there were no formal grievances registered.
