### **ABOUT THE INSTITUTION**

St. Joseph's College of Commerce (SJCC) formerly a part of St. Joseph's College, established in the year 1882, is managed by the Bangalore Jesuit Educational Society (BJES). The college's vision includes a model for higher education that encourages individuals to dream of a socially just world and its mission outlines a strategy to empower individuals to realise that dream. The innovations were further bolstered by the granting of autonomous status to the college by the UGC in September 2005. The college has undergone four cycles of NAAC accreditation, beginning in 2000 when it secured 'Five Stars'; in 2007, it earned an 'A' grade; in 2012, it again received an 'A' grade; and in February 2021, it was awarded an 'A++'.

It is one of the very few institutions in the country to have secured an A++ grade in the fourth cycle under the Revised Accreditation Framework (RAF) and the first college in Karnataka to do so. The college was declared a 'College with Potential for Excellence' in 2010. In 2011, SJCC was recognised as a Research Centre by Bangalore University. The college has consistently been ranked among the top 100 colleges in the country by the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), Ministry of Education, Government of India, since NIRF's inception in 2017.



### ABOUT ICSSR - SRC

The primary objective of the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) is to promote research in the social sciences and to facilitate the utilisation of its vast resources. The ICSSR has Six Regional Centres in India, among which the Southern Regional Centre is one. The ICSSR-SRC, established in 1973 in collaboration with Osmania University and the Government of Andhra Pradesh, serves the southern states.

The major role of the Southern Regional Centre is to act as an agent of the ICSSR within the southern region, to represent social scientists and bring their ideas and concerns to the ICSSR in New Delhi; to provide a platform for social scientists of the region to collaborate for the promotion of social science research; and to serve as a link between the region's social scientists and the national and international community of social scientists. The jurisdiction of the Southern Regional Centre extends to the states of Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, and Telangana and the Union Territories of Lakshadweep and Puducherry.
